## Quilter Recipe Corner

### Amish Breakfast Casserole

**Prep Time:** 15 Min

**Cook Time:** 35 Min

**Ready In:** 50 Min

**Yields** 12 servings

#### Ingredients:

- 1 pound sliced bacon, diced ( I used 1/2 lb)
- 1 medium sweet onion, chopped ( I used 1 bunch green onion)
- 6 eggs, lightly beaten ( I added a bit of milk)
- 4 cups frozen shredded hash brown potatoes, thawed ( I used 3 cups)
- 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1 1/2 cups small curd cottage cheese
- 1 1/4 cups shredded Swiss cheese

#### Directions:

1. In a large skillet, cook bacon and onion until bacon is crisp; drain. In a bowl, combine the remaining ingredients; stir in bacon mixture. Transfer to a greased 13-in. x 9-in. x 2-in. baking dish.
2. Bake, uncovered, at 350 degrees F for 35-40 minutes or until set and bubbly. Let stand for 10 minutes before cutting.

*This is a great "make ahead" dish for that Sunday morning brunch.*
